



The Clark Family Center is currently under construction on a 17,741 sf parcel that is a component of the Catholic Charities Master Plan. Lundin Cole Architects designed and is providing construction administration for this four-story plus basement 60,000 sf multi-purpose office building. Catholic Charities will occupy 2.5 floors as their new headquarters. A Loaves & Fishes meal preparation and dining facility and a Grandma's Place Early Childhood Development Center will occupy the ground floor retail space. The building will be constructed of cast-in-place concrete walls, floors and roof, and have a masonry rain screen skin. Photovoltaic solar power is scheduled to be installed on the rooftop. Project completion is slated for April, 2010. LCA successfully achieved a zoning code height adjustment, other adjustments, and building code appeals through the City of Portland.
