Ted Lundin and John Cole developed this 78,000 square foot academic center at the University of Portland. The three lower floors were designed to incorporate a variety of multimedia teaching tools. The upper two floors were designated as offices for the Schools of Business and Education. Fronting the building on the main campus quadrangle is a large grass amphitheater designed for special events. The building's Neoclassic design incorporates a two-story archway that complements the most historic building on campus.
