



Originally constructed in 1890, the Barber Block Building housed many businesses over the years, including a mortuary, vaudeville theater, furniture store, laundry, and most recently, a restaurant and bar. Ground floor improvements included seismic reinforcement of the brick shell, handicap accessibility upgrades, new mechanical and electrical systems, site improvements, as well as new finishes and furnishings.

The historic quality of the building was retained and highlighted with the interior design by IDEA. LCA shepherded the project through the City of Portland Design Review, as well as handled construction administration duties.
